Note by the Secretary-General.

The following letter from M. V. Papasian, President of the Armenian Delegation is circulated to the Members of the Council and of the League of Nations for their information.

Sir.

According to corroborative information received from private sources, an agreement was signed at Kars on October 13th 1921, between the representatives of Angora on the one hand and the Bolshevik representatives of Moscow, Erivan, Tiflis and Baku on the other, regulating the question of frontiers and other questions pending between the Caucasian Republics and Turkey.

The Armenian Delegation to the Peace Conference wishes to draw the attention of the Council of the League of Nations to the fact that the Bolshevik administration which has been imposed upon Armenia by force of arms, and by whose representatives the

above-mentioned agreement was signed, does not in any way represent the national wishes; the Armenian Delegation therefore desires to state that it makes the most formal reservations with regard to any partial or general infringement by the agreement in question of the terms of the Treaty of Sevres, and the rights which have been acquired by Armenia and recognised as herein virtue of international agreements.
